

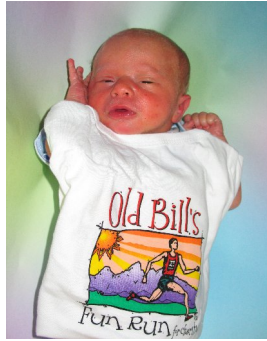

Race to be First Old Bill's Baby Ends with Home Delivery

Community Foundation of Jackson Hole Releases Old Bill's Baby "Onesies"



JACKSON, WY.—July 9, 2007—The Community Foundation of Jackson Hole is pleased to introduce *Baby Bills*. Included in *Baby Bills* is a new line of Old Bill's Fun Run apparel --Baby Onesies -- and a diaper derby race. For those not currently changing diapers, onesies are cute little baby body suits that fit over a diaper. The Community Foundation is giving them away to all supporters of Old Bill's Fun Run who would like to see their favorite Baby Bill in an Old Bill's Onesie.

In addition to distributing the Onesies at the Community Foundation office, the Foundation is partnering with St. John's Medical Center, adding the onsies to the new baby welcome basket. Lindsey and Justin Haga of Pinedale, WY are the proud parents of Jonathan Cash Haga. Jonathan -- the first Baby Bill -- was born on July 4, 2007, the first day of the Old Bill's 11 giving period. Knowing the honor and distinction that comes with being the first Old Bill's Baby, Jonathan was in quite a rush to beat the competition. He gave Mom less than an hour's notice and was therefore born in the ambulance outside of his parent's home, arriving at St. John's Medical Center shortly after.

All Baby Bills will be eligible to compete in the new diaper derby by crawling to the finish line clad in their Old Bill's onesies (no registration required). The winner of the derby will receive \$100 to donate to his or her (parent's) favorite participating organization. "When you are born in Jackson Hole, you are born into the most generous community in the nation," commented Brendan McDermott, Old Bill's Fun Run Coordinator and Public Relations Officer. "It is never too early to introduce the giving spirit of Mr. and Mrs. Old Bill!"

Onesies are now available in sizes 6 months and 12 months. You can pick one up at the Community Foundation office when making a donation to or registering for Old Bill's Fun Run 11. Additionally, each baby born at St. John's Medical Center (or on the way to St. John's) will receive a onesie in his or her welcome basket.

The first event of its kind in the nation, the idea for Old Bill's Fun Run for Charities came from an anonymous couple that has so far provided \$5 million in matching funds over ten-years to encourage local philanthropy. Through the event, organized annually by the Community Foundation of Jackson Hole, the community has raised more than \$45.7 million to benefit local charities. Last year, Old Bill's Fun Run 10 for Charities raised in excess of \$6.8 million for 205 local non-profits with 2,800 people running, walking or wheeling in the event. Old Bill's Fun Run 11 for Charities will be held on September 8, 2007.
