# Competitive Grants Eligibility

## Previous Eligibility Requirements

- IRS approved charitable entity and religious organizations.
- Grant funds must be used in Teton County, Wyoming.
- Grant report on file for previous year

## 2021 Eligibility Requirements

- IRS approved charitable entity and religious organizations.
- Grant funds must be used in Teton County, Wyoming.
- Updated use of funds approved by Foundation staff.
- Extension of grant report approved by Foundation staff.

## **CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT ([CARES ACT](#))**

A \$2 trillion economic stimulus law intended to provide immediate relief for individuals, nonprofits, businesses, and state and local governments. Key provisions of sector-wide interest to charitable nonprofit organizations include the following:

- **Emergency Injury Disaster Loans (EIDL)**

Created emergency grants for eligible nonprofits and other applicants with 500 or fewer employees enabling them to receive checks for \$10,000 within three days. [More information](#)

- **Charitable Giving Incentive** - Creates a new about-the-line deduction (universal or non-itemizer deduction that applies to all taxpayers) for total contributions up to \$300.

- **Employee Retention Payroll Tax Credit** - Creates a refundable payroll tax credit of up to \$5,000 of each employee on the payroll when certain conditions are met.

## CARES ACT CONTINUED:

- **Delayed Payment of Payroll Taxes** - Allows employers to delay payment of the employer portion payroll taxes in 2020.
- **Economic Stabilization Fund** - Creates a loan and loan guarantee program for industries that have not otherwise received economic relief in the form of loans or loan guarantees. Mid-sized nonprofits and business that have been 500 and 10,000 employees are eligible for loans under this provision. The parameters of this program is still being worked out.

## THE FAMILIES FIRST CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE ACT

- On March 19th, the President signed into law, H.R., 6201 [The Families First Coronavirus Response Act](#). The bill includes a complex set of temporary paid leave mandates and employer reimbursement provisions, as well as funding for free coronavirus testing, food nutrition security, and unemployment extension.
