



**Community Foundation of Jackson Hole awards \$725,000 to local nonprofits**

**Jackson, WY** - The Community Foundation of Jackson Hole announced today that its Competitive Grants program supported 50 nonprofit organizations with a total of \$725,000 during its 2022 granting cycle. The Community Foundation’s grants extend across fields of interest including Animals, Arts & Culture, Civic, Conservation & Environment, Education, Health & Human Services, and Sports & Recreation.

“These grant applications afford the best education about what is working – and what isn’t – in our community,” remarked Marcia Kunstel, Chair of the Foundation’s Competitive Grants Committee. “Many nonprofits are still trying to catch up after losing financial ground during the pandemic. At the same time, they have faced greater needs. Creative and resilient, they have continued to provide services to the people and places that comprise our Jackson Hole neighborhood. We are fortunate to lend them a hand with grant funding, thanks to our concerned donors.”

The grant requests were reviewed by a volunteer committee comprised of 33 community members, high school students, and Community Foundation board and staff. Awards are based upon community need, projected impact, and organizational capacity. Funding for the Community Foundation’s Competitive Grants Program is provided by Old Bill’s Fun Run Co-Challengers, individual donors and endowed funds held at the Community Foundation of Jackson Hole.
